Budget Public Hearing/Water Law Public Hearing & Special Meeting

Present: Supervisor Edward Bender, Councilman Alan Wood, Councilman Dan Wiley, Councilman Marty Mason and approximately 13 visitors.

Absent: Councilman Paul Aubertine, excused.

Supervisor Bender opened the budget public hearing at 6:30pm with the pledge of allegiance.

Public Comment

Elizabeth Brennan – Liz told the board that she has reviewed the budget and said that she has a few questions and comments. She said that the town's budget reads a little different than the villages and asked what the asterisk represented. She asked about the line in the budget for the Medical Center and what the town is responsible for. The board told her that the town is responsible for the inside of the building and Councilman Mason told her that the asterisk represent the line had no money in it before. Liz asked about Community Development and the LDC. She reviewed the budget line and asked why the board was paying Scott Burto to be the Planner and Tim White for the Club Street project, as she feels this is a duplication of services. Liz also asked the board where the interest payment line is and what the board has spent so far on the Club Street project.

Donna Essegian – Donna said that it was her understanding that the ambulance squad was having a fund raiser with the purpose of replacing the current ambulance. She wanted to know why the town was budgeting for its replacement. Councilman Wiley said that the town was budgeting to help them become self-sufficient. He said that the town will have to budget funds each year to help. Councilman Wiley told her that the board has reviewed options and one is to create a line on the tax bill. Donna asked about the General Fund line regarding the State income taxes, what the Cultural Recreation Youth Program is and why the Highway's Transportation line increased by 10%. Councilman Mason said that the highway was going to hire an employee because they did not hire anyone new when Bill Pond became the Superintendent. He also said that the highway had budgeted for a new piece of equipment.

Debra Suller – Deb said that she would like to have the board prepare an Executive Summary of the budget for next year. She said this would help people understand the codes for each budget line. She asked about the highway crew salary increase. She thanked the board for keeping the budget under the 2% tax cap.

Councilman Wood made a motion to close the budget public hearing at 6:50pm, seconded by Councilman Wiley. All members present voted AYE.

Councilman Wood made a motion to open the public hearing regarding Local Law #3 the Common Water Law, seconded by Councilman Wiley.

Public Comments

Debra Suller – Deb said that she was happy to see that the board has put clarifications to some of the law. She said that she had worked on this a few years ago and appreciates the work the board has done on updating the water law.

Councilman Wood made a motion to close the water law public hearing and open the special meeting at 6:52pm, seconded by Councilman Mason. All members present voted AYE.
