Special Town Board Meeting

Present: Supervisor Marty Mason, Councilman Dan Wiley, Councilman Tim Maloney, Councilman Alan Wood, David Powers from Barton & Lodguidice

Supervisor Mason called the meeting to order at 3:00pm with the pledge of allegiance.

David Powers reviewed with the board the 18 sections of the SEQRA. The board reviewed part 2 of the EAF and determined that the proposed sewer project will have no adverse impact on the environment.

Councilman Wiley made a motion to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Negative Declaration, seconded by Councilman Maloney. All members present voted AYE.

Resolution #52

Resolution #52 was moved by Councilman Wiley, seconded by Councilman Maloney. Resolution #52 is to declare the sewer district is a Type 1 action under the SEQRA process, that the town will act as the Lead Agency, and that the sewer project will have no adverse effect on the environment.
